During Paul's first Missionary Journey where they traveled to Cyprus

- He also sent a letter to the Galatians which mainly was written addressing the critical issues of faith and law.

- For example, Paul reaffirms his former teachings that the Mosaic Law is obsolete and that if they returned to Jewish practice like circumcision to therefore regressive through the faith. Paul's most stood out letter was to the Ephesians. Where he had an extortionary vision which was trying to address the concerns, challenges, and needs of early Christian communities and their practices
